2008: Supervising producer for first season of “How Stuff Works” on Discovery Networks.

2012: Production manager for all video projects created by The Wilderness Society.

2018: Managing editor for the relaunch of The Lone Peak Lookout in Big Sky.

2019: Field production manager and lead producer for the Discovery + doc “First to the Top of the World.”

2019-2020: Showrunner and production manager for HBO Max series “4th & Forever.”
